## **PENTICTON TRIATHLON CLUB**

1.0 Meeting called to order at 7:08PM

2.0 Review minutes of March meeting minutes. Ryan motioned to accept the minutes of March's meeting as correct. Gord seconded.

Brad will email the people who earlier said they are interested, as we still require certified coaches for the junior camp and for the group workouts.

4.4 **Grand Columbian Challenge**. Brad still needs to send out a club email to advise members about this, and to see if we can get a team to compete in the Challenge.
