August 3, 2010 Meeting Minutes

1. **Meeting** called to order at 7:08 PM
2. **Review** of July 6 meeting minutes. Accepted by Darryl.
3. **Business** from July 6 minutes. No IMC locals jersey this year. This is due to no master list of local athletes from IMC. In past years Jane was able to get this list to Brad. Gord made a list off of the IMC website, but it lacks email and telephone. Club needs a volunteer to take this on for next year.
4. **Correspondence:** Following the BP Jr. Tri, Laura received an email of complaint from Glen Cairns, artistic director of a play currently taking place on the beach where the kids finish their swim. A letter has been mailed to all members of the S.S. Sicamous Restoration Society, with a copy of the email, stating that all complaints are erroneous, and to acknowledge this fact.
5. **Treasurer's Report:**

6. **Old Business:**
 - a. Troyce reports on Boston Pizza Jr. Triathlon. 100 athletes participated, and approximately \$1500 was earned from the event. More people attended the carbo dinner than ever before. Al has already sent a cheque for the "Post Event" summary. Troyce would like a better report from the head official, post race. There is a possibility that next years event could be a Junior Provincial championship, and could host the Elite Junior championships, and possibly be the Western Regional championships.
 - b. The Bare Bones received an invoice from Tri BC for \$60 for 2 officials. Brad forgot that Tri BC will pay for only 2 officials. The additional officials are the responsibility of the event. Brad said that 4-6 officials are really needed, especially when the event is the provincial championships.
 - c. Club supported ride went well. 9 riders, of varying rider levels. Brad organized, with 2 drivers, Dale Ward (club member from Vancouver Island) and Karen Lannon. Much appreciated thanks to Dale and Karen for volunteering to help. Brad took his bike along, and rode from Husky on, showing a couple of riders the route off Hwy 3, through the out and backs.
7. **New Business**

- a. Laura asked if the club will sponsor another “Good News Bear”, with proceeds to the local Food Bank. Brad said that the club is not-for-profit, and the Food Bank is typically a benefactor. Darryl motioned that “the Penticton Triathlon Club provide a Good News Bear to charity (Food Bank) for club awareness. Laura seconded. All in favour.
- b. Queries related to local entry for IMC 2011 have been made by Laura to Joe Dixon. Brad has said that a few locals have asked. No reply yet. Client services according to the website are now handled by Heather Fuhr. As a comparison, IM Coeur D’Alene had 235 local athletes competing there.
- c. Ironman Canada is looking for locals willing to billet a professional athlete from out of town. Contact James Palanio if you are able to help. Volunteers are still needed for the race.
- d. Tri BC AGM is coming up. Troyce, Laura, and Brad should see if they can attend.
